Parking for vendors is available behind your tent for 1 vehicle and additional parking is directly adjacent to our section. Vendors may set up on Friday afternoon and evening.

The fee for participating in the Antiques and Flea Market for the 50th Annual Bluemont Fair is \$130.00 which includes both Saturday and Sunday. This is a non-refundable fee due with your application. The Bluemont Fair is rain or shine.
